E-R-T offers an alternative path to Florida's K-12 ESOL Endorsement for educators who already have Florida's Reading Endorsement. This alternative recognizes 120 hours of inservice credit from reading endorsement coursework. Based on the analysis of the Florida Department of Education Reverse Crosswalk, Beacon recommends the courses in the chart below to meet the state-defined program.

Through a series of Beacon online courses, participants explore concepts and principles of applied linguistics and learn how these relate to English language learners (ELLs). They practice effective methods of teaching ELLs, gain awareness of various cultures, and learn to differentiate instruction to accommodate various students' needs. In the practicum, participants apply knowledge of ESOL-appropriate instructional practices through the creation and implementation of instructional plans.
