Engage in the systematic problem-solving process to identify students with reading difficulties, including identification of students with characteristics of dyslexia, provide appropriate interventions and conduct effective progress monitoring.
Reading 3: Assessment	60	Understand how to select and administer assessments and analyze data to inform reading instruction to meet the needs of all students. Engage in the systematic problem-solving process to identify characteristics of conditions such as dyslexia, provide appropriate interventions and conduct effective progress monitoring.
Reading 4: Differentiated Instruction R+	60	Gain broad knowledge of students from differing profiles in order to understand and apply evidence-based instructional practices by differentiating process, product, and context. Engage in the systematic problem-solving process to identify characteristics of conditions such as dyslexia, provide appropriate interventions and conduct effective progress monitoring.
Reading 5: Demonstration of Accomplishment R+	60	Through a culminating practicum, demonstrate knowledge of the components of reading, as well as assessments and data analysis, to implement a comprehensive evidence-based reading plan of instruction for all students. Engage in the systematic problem-solving process to identify characteristics of conditions such as dyslexia, provide approve interventions and conduct effective progress monitoring.
